# Windows 2003 Server increase system partition size fast and easily

All the size of the hard disk partitions are carefully allocated while building the Windows 2003 Server. To avoid waste of space, many Server administrators allocate small partition size to system C drive, generally

5GB to 15GB. Even if you create a very large system partition, you'll be amazed at how quickly application/Windows update installs, browser caches, and temporary files can eat up your free space and clutter your system.

Originally, you have to backup the system and files, delete partitions, recreate larger system partition and restore. What a time-consuming work. You whole happy weekend will be wasted to install Windows updates and large amount of applications.

New computer technology make things much easier, nowadays, you can increase Server 2003 system partition size directly, without so much annoying works. The reliable Server partition software helps you increase Windows 2003 system partition size fast and easily.

## How to extend Server 2003 system partition size

Two choices:

1. Merge system partition and a data partition directly. (How to merge Server 2003 partitions)

After that, the free space of original data partition becomes part of the partition size of system partition.

2. Resize partitions

Shrink an existing data partition to release some Unallocated space at the end of the system partition, which can be used to increase system partition size, no need to delete, format partition or rebuild the Server.

# Steps to resize partition and increase Server 2003 system partition size

Step 1, Launch Partition Magic Server, you'll see all disks and partitions that connected to your Server and free space, used space and other properties of each partition.




Right-click the data partition and select "Resize", in the pop-up window, drag the left border rightwards to shrink it.






There will be some Unallocated space behind the system partition.



Step 2, Right-click the system partition and select "Resize", in the pop-up window, drag the right border rightwards to hold the Unallocated space.



Click "Apply" to proceed, done.



Now you have a "new" Server that can be used for a long time again.  $\label{eq:constraint}$
